General information regarding the arrival data:

- The total number of cases broken down by Nationality may be larger than number of cases (families) noted at the top of the chart. This indicates family groupings may consist of more than one nationality.
- Arrival numbers are reported based on the Resettlement Agency. Most arrivals originally live in cities or surrounding areas close to where the agency is located, with the exception of a few remote placements.
- Data is derived from the Bureau of Population, Refugees and Migration. While this is generally the 'official' data presented for state arrivals, a few additional individuals/cases may arrive through other pre-approved channels.
